Our regular outdoor restaurant hours will continue to be open to all. This combination of protocols is the safest way forward for us to operate, my opinion, and has everyone’s best interest in mind.

One more change. We are starting with **ONLINE TICKETING** only. I suggest you pick your shows early knowing there may be reduced capacity and that in a week the schedule will be promoted to the general public. Ticket prices are scaled slightly higher but know that the majority of that money always goes to the musicians, all of whom have been out of work since March of 2020.
